Petter Berg is a Partner based in RBB's Nordic office in Stockholm. He has been working in the field of competition economics since 2002 at the Swedish Competition Authority, as a private consultant and in academia. Petter has worked on a wide range of important merger cases, both pre-merger assessments and phase I and phase II investigations. He has also defended prohibited mergers in court proceedings (Arla). Petter has worked on mergers both before national competition authorities and the European Commission, across all sectors of the economy.

He has advised clients in several high-profile abuse of dominance cases in Sweden for clients such as Nasdaq, Geberit and Postkod Lotteriet. He also has significant experience from cartel and litigation cases where he worked for clients such as Stora Enso and GothNet.

Petter also has experience with sector specific regulation, primarily from electronic communication markets, healthcare and pharmaceutical markets.

Petter regularly acts as an economic expert witness in court.

He holds a Ph.D. in economics from Copenhagen Business School where he also taught microeconomics, econometrics and industrial organisation.
